Takunda is a seven-year Resilience Food Security Activity (RFSA) funded by the United States Agency for International Development (USAID). The program is led by CARE Zimbabwe supported by its implementing partners: Bulawayo Projects Centre (BPC), Environment Africa (EA), the Food, Agriculture and Natural Resources Policy Analysis Network (FANRPAN), Family Health International (FHI360), the International Crops Research Institute for the Semi-Arid Tropics (ICRISAT), International Youth Foundation (IYF) and Nutrition Action Zimbabwe (NAZ). The project is being implemented in two provinces namely: Manicaland Province (in Mutare and Buhera Rural Districts) and Masvingo Province (in Chivi and Zaka Rural Districts).

Takunda seeks to promote sustainable, equitable, and resilient food, nutrition, and income for at-risk groups, namely: the extremely poor, the chronically vulnerable, and those at risk of malnutrition. The project aims to directly impact 301,636 people in 77,211 households across all-purpose areas by increasing household gender-equitable income, nutrition status, and resilience to shocks and stressors.
